## PRACTICAL TIPS FOR ACCOMODATION AND TRANSPORTATION

- 1. Taxis from Adolfo Suárez Madrid Barajas Airport have a fixed rate (33 euros) to Downton Madrid.
- 2. The Universidad Complutense de Madrid has a metro station (Ciudad Universitaria), although there are no hotels nearby. For just one day, it is probably worth it to get a taxi from the hotel to the Law Faculty.
- 3. Unfortunately, our University has no "special agreements" (i.e. special prices) with any hotel, but these ones (below) are equally distant from the University and from the Downtown (more or less, walking distance should be no more than 30 minutes from any of them):
  - Exe Moncloa (Arcipreste de Hita, 10, Chamberí, 28015 Madrid, España)
  - Motel One Madrid-Plaza de España (Tutor, 1, Moncloa Aravaca, 28008
     Madrid, España)
  - Aparto-Hotel Rosales (Marqués De Urquijo, 23, Moncloa Aravaca, 28008 Madrid, España)
  - Sercotel Gran Hotel Conde Duque (Plaza del Conde Valle Suchil, 5, Chamberí, 28015 Madrid, España)
- 4. Should you want to stay closer to, for example, most "iconic" places like the Prado Museum, these ones could be a good choice:
  - Petit Palace Lealtad Plaza (Antonio Maura, 5, Retiro, 28014 Madrid, España)
  - Petit Palace Savoy Alfonso XII (Alfonso XII, 18, Retiro, 28014 Madrid, España)
